## Opening February 2021

As The Lucky Onion, Sam and Georgie Pearson created some of the Cotswolds' most in-demand spots, including The Wheatsheaf Inn. They sold out to Superdry founder Julian Dunkerton in 2017 and are now gathering a new brood of inns under the banner of Country Creatures. This spring they add The Double Red Duke in the tiny village of Clanfield, west of Oxford, by repurposing a honey-stoned former coaching inn. The couple are working with sustainable British brands and makers on the renovation, which includes deep iso-enamel tubs from The Albion Bath Co in Essex and designs from Wiltshire fabric producers Fermoie. Downstairs, Hawksmoor and Pitt Cue Co veterans Richard E Turner and Richard Sandiford will be firing up the open grill for a meaty menu of charcoal-grilled

tomahawk steaks and oyster and bone-marrow gravy. A perfectly pitched pub for a countryside-stomping spring escape.
