WALKS

With our surrounding countryside you'll be able to find impressive views and great walks. Please ask at Reception as we have maps of our favourite local walks.

A FEW PLACES TO VISIT:

If you are a fan of the popular TV show Downton Abbey you will recognize many of the sites in Bampton 1.7 miles away where many of the scenes were shot.

Burford situated 8 miles away, is a lovely ancient, Cotswold town with great walks and cafes, restaurants and pubs.

The internationally renowned Bronze-Age Uffington White Horse (13 miles) can be seen for miles, and is also on the Ridgeway footpath. From here you get some fantastic views across Oxfordshire.

World famous Blenheim Palace (19 miles) is a World Heritage Site with over 300 years of History and home to the 12th Duke of Marlborough and his Family.

Oxford: we don't need to explain the historic importance or beauty of Oxford but it's not far (about 30 minutes drive) and not to be missed if you haven't been before.

SAILING

We are very lucky to have the largest inland lake area in the UK, the Cotswolds Water Park, in Cirencester. Here you can do lake swimming, sailing, wind surfing, kayaking, water skiing or even just relaxing on a beach (great for children in the summertime, with a large play area, peak times and at weekends).

SHOPPING

Located 30 minutes away from Clanfield, is the Westgate shopping center in Oxford which is home to lots of global brands, eclectic restaurants and cafes, leisure and sophisticated rooftop bars and dining.

Alternatively, forty minutes away is Bicester Village. It has over 160 luxury and high street brands alongside restaurants and cafes so it's great for a day of bargain hunting with discounts of up to 60% off the high street prices.

LOCAL ATTRACTIONS

Kelmscott Manor: a few minutes away by car from the Double Red Duke is the stunning manor house and inspirational Cotswold retreat of William Morris. When Morris first saw the Manor in 1871, he was delighted by this 'loveliest haunt of ancient peace'.

He signed a joint lease for the property with his friend and colleague Dante Gabriel Rossetti, the Pre-Raphaelite artist. From April to October, you can visit the Manor every Wednesday and Saturday, 11.00am to 5.00pm. Last admission to the Manor House 4pm. In addition to visiting the Manor house and gardens, you can explore their licensed Tea Room and lovely gift shop. You can download their beautiful map to help you find your way around. From November to March, the Manor is 'put to bed'. During this time, the Manor is not open to the public.

CHEDWORTH: close to the village of Chedworth is a nearly intact Roman Villa. The site was excavated in 1864 and retains a Victorian atmosphere. Over a mile of walls survives and there are several fine mosaics, two bathhouses, hypocausts, a water shrine and latrine. The museum houses objects from the villa and also has its own gift shop and café. Open March through to November.

COTSWOLD FARM PARK: Home of Adam Henson, a rare farm treat for all the family, offering the chance to meet over 50 breeding flocks and herds of farm animals. SHERBORNE ESTATE AND LODGE PARK: Lodge Park is a unique example of a 17th century deer course and park. The grandstand, an ornate stone building dating from 1634, has been extensively restored. It provides fine views of the course and surrounding parkland. Family walks or indeed strolls with your four legged friends, on the Sherborne Park Estate, there's plenty of countryside to explore. The National Trust work closely with the community to create sculptures which are dotted round the estate and embedded into the natural scenery.
